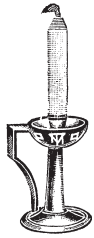


Past Pursuits at Clear Creek History Park

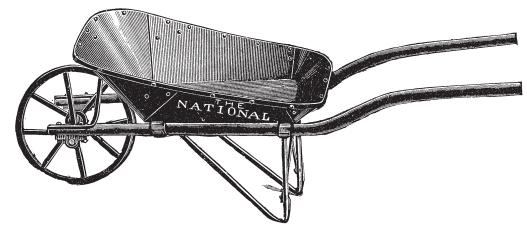
AUGUST 5TH - 7TH

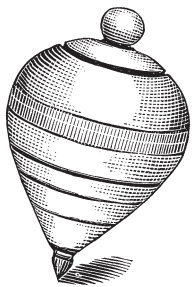
AUGUST 12TH - 14TH

Saturday: Chickens - Meet at the chicken coop to learn about the different heirloom breeds, take a coop tour and make a pine cone bird feeder.

AUGUST 19TH - 22ND



Thursday: Schoolhouse Lessons - It's time for school, so grab your slates and get ready to attend our one-room schoolhouse and play pioneer games during recess.

Friday: Jams and Jellies - Every pantry needs homemade preserves, and this is your chance to watch this simple process in action.

Saturday & Sunday: Fine Arts Festival - Lace making, leather tooling and blacksmithing were part of life on the frontier. Talk with local experts and watch demonstrations of these traditional skills, taste what's cooking on the woodstove and say hello to the chickens.

Thursday: Clear Creek History Park Tours - Get to know all the buildings and find out where they came from and who brought them to Golden. Tours start every hour at the Pearce/Helps Cabin.

Friday: Sewing and Samplers - Some skills never go out of style. Try your hand at knitting and making a sampler at the Pearce/Helps Cabin.
